## Over the Counter Medications

The Board of Nursing and the School Health Resource Manuel recommend that a parent/guardian give their consent for the administration of Over-the-Counter medications to the students in a school setting. Below is the list of available Over-the-Counter medications for your student during school day with your consent.

<u>Please Initial all that apply.</u> Your child will not be given any medication that you have not approved. You will be contacted as needed. Medication will be administered in age appropriate dose as recommended by manufacturer or as specified by parent/guardian or physician. All medication will be administered by school nurse or medication trained designee.

Tylenol (Acetaminophen) tablet, liquid or chewable	Tums for stomach upset
Ibuprofen (Advil) liquid, tablet	Cough Drop
Benadryl (Diphenhydramine) for allergic reaction	Hydrocortisone Cream for itch, bug bites
Calamine Lotion for bug bites, itch	Bacitracin Ointment (triple antibiotic ointment)
Other- to be supplied by parent/guardian in manufacturer labeled container and used as directed (in writing) by parent/guardian.
